SECTION I. BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT BULGARIA

Location

The Republic of Bulgaria lies in Southeastern Europe, and is situated in the eastern half of the Balkan Peninsula. It borders the Black Sea to the east, Greece and Turkey to the south, Serbia and the Republic of Macedonia to the west and Romania to the North, mostly along the Danube River.



A brief history of Bulgaria

Bulgaria has a rich history spanning 1300 years. **Old Great Bulgaria** was founded by Khan Kubrat in 632 A.D. comprising of a territory that spread between the Caucasus, the Volga River and the Carpathian mountains. Around 654 A.D. Great Bulgaria was divided into three parts. One of Kubrat's sons, Asparukh, migrated towards the Danube delta to the west, where he formed the 'Danube Bulgaria'. The year 681 A.D. is considered the beginning of the **First Bulgarian Empire**, when Khan Asparukh signed a peace treaty with Thrace. Bulgaria saw an upsurge in cultural development during this period, until 1018 A.D. The Cyrillic alphabet was created at this point, updated versions of which are used in the Bulgarian, Russian, Macedonian, Serbian, Ukrainian, Mongolian and Belarusian languages. During the reign of Tsar Simeon I, Great Bulgaria entered a period which was later called the Golden Age of Bulgarian literature. Bulgaria was under **Byzantine rule** during the period 1018-1186 A.D. In 1186 A.D. the brothers Asen and Peter established the **Second Bulgarian Empire** with its capital based in Veliko Turnovo. In 1396 A.D., the country came under **Ottoman rule**; this lasted five centuries until March 3, 1878, when the Treaty of San Stefano was signed and the Bulgarian state restored. The Union of Eastern Rumelia with the Bulgarian Principality was proclaimed on September 6, 1885, the independence of Bulgaria was officially declared on September 22, 1908, with the government being formed by the monarchy lead by Tsar Boris III. After World War II, Bulgaria fell within the Soviet sphere of influence and in 1946 became a People's Republic. The beginning of Bulgaria's transition from communism to a market economics was made at the end of 1989. In 2004, Bulgaria successfully completed negotiations with the European Union and, since January 1, 2007, Bulgaria has been a full member of EU.

Climate

Bulgaria has a temperate continental climate (2000 to 2400 sunny hours annually), with four seasons: a cold and sometimes damp winter with regular snowfall and an average temperature of 0° C; a warm and very often damp spring; a hot and dry summer with average temperatures of 26° C, and a warm and sunny autumn. The average annual temperature is around 10.5° C

Tourism

Tourism plays a major part in the Bulgarian economics. The country is rich with cultural and historical sights. Tourism has developed mostly along the Black sea coast and in the mountains, with the most popular sea resorts being Golden sands, Sunny Beach, Albena, Nessebur and Sozopol, and the most popular mountain resorts, Borovets, Pamporovo and Bansko.

SECTION II. BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT SVISHTOV

Location

Svishtov is situated in Central Northern Bulgaria, on the eastern bank of the Danube River. The town lies 2,295 km from the springs where it originates and 555 km from the river's estuary. This is where the most southern point of the Danube river ($43^{\circ} 37'$ north) is located. The port of Svishtov is the only Danube port that is this far inside the borders of the country and is the shortest way from the Danube through the Stara Planina passes and the valley of the Maritsa River to the Aegean Sea.

The location, the rich fertile land, the large river –these have all created favourable conditions for the settlement and construction of many villages around the territory of the present town of Svishtov. Archaeological excavations and funeral mounds in this area prove the existence of a number of prehistoric villages which were constructed during the Neolithic, Eneolithic and Bronze Ages. Many artefacts have also been discovered from the early Iron Age, when Thracian tribes settled here. The Roman town of Nove (Novgrad, Novo Selishte) was built on the foundations of an early Thracian village and existed for almost six centuries (from the first to the seventh century A.D). During the whole period of its existence, Nove has been a border crossing. When Claudius, the Roman emperor, was in power, the VIII Augustus Legion resided in Nove, and the First Italic Legion was also based there from 69 A.D. until the end of antiquity. The Roman and late Graeco-Roman town of Novae (Nove) is included in the list of the 100 most endangered cultural sites (<http://wmf.org>) in the world. The excavations of the Roman town of Novae are 3.5 km to the east of Svishtov. There has also been another, separate Roman village on the site of present-day Svishtov (in Kaleto place), that has had subsidiary functions regarding the 1st Italic legion in Nove. This village in Kaleto existed during the First Bulgarian Empire, during Byzantine rule, the Second Bulgarian Empire and the Ottoman rule.

The mediaeval fortress of Svishtov – the Fortress of Rocky Peak (Kaleto) was built on the ruins of an ancient Roman tower. So far, some half-intact walls, reaching 7 m in height, have been preserved. An amphitheatre and a sun dial were built at the “Kaleto” park in Svishtov in 2005. This is one of the many parks in the town, which is the perfect place not only for rest, but also for various cultural events. At the beginning of the 19th century, the town had the

reputation for being an important trade and educational centre. It is one of the busiest ports on the Danube and serves as a connection between Bulgaria and the West for the import and export of goods.

Svishtov is a town which has seen 100 original developments. Here are some of the most important ones:

- The first donation to a school was made in 1812 by Phillip Sakelarievich, who was born in Svishtov, but was trading in Vienna;
- Svishtov was the first town liberated from the Turkish yoke and the first civil administration was also established here;
- The first high-school of trade in Bulgaria was founded in Svishtov thanks to a donation by Dimitar Hadzhivasilev from Svishtov, and was built by the Austrian architect Paul Brant in the style of the famous high school in Vienna;
- The history of choral singing began in Svishtov, with the first Bulgarian choir being founded in Svishtov in 1868;
- The first Bulgarian cultural house was created in Svishtov by a donation from Kiril D. Avramov;
- Svishtov is the birthplace of the author of the first book printed in the modern Bulgarian language, Philip Stanislavov. The author of the Bulgarian anthem, Tsvetan Radoslavov and the great writer Aleko Konstantinov were also born here.

Svishtov is also well-known as the town of benefactors. There is no significant initiative, building, school, church or institution, that has not had benefactors supporting them via private donations: The Dimitar A. Tsenov

Academy of Economics; The Dimitar Hadzhivasilev High School for Trade; The Kiril D. Avramov First Bulgarian cultural house (which is a theatre and museum today), and about 600 more benefactors appeared in Svishtov during the Bulgarian national revival alone.

Climate

The area's terrain is slightly hilly, with level plains below. This, and the fact that the town is open to the north, means that air currents flow from the continent. Due to the continental character of our climate, summers are hot and dry whilst winters are cold with abundant snowfall.

Transport

Svishtov lies 260 km from Sofia, 260 km from Varna, 90 km from Gorna Oryahovitsa, and Pleven and Russe and 90 km from Veliko Turnovo. You can travel to these towns by train or bus. You can also take a taxi to Svishtov.

You can sail with the regular passenger ferry from Zimnich (Romania) to Svishtov and back every Friday, Saturday and Sunday – a one-way ticket costs EUR 5.00.

Banks

Banks will exchange foreign currency and traveller's cheques for leva and vice versa. Foreign residents may open bank accounts in leva (levs) or in a foreign currency and it is also possible to send money orders and transfer payments via banks and Western Union offices.

Money can be changed at exchange offices in hotels and numerous small private exchange offices in the town. Working hours are usually between 10.00 to 20.00.

There are many Bulgarian and foreign banks in Svishtov. Working hours are usually between 8.30 to 16.30, but this depends on the branch you use. Banks are not normally open on Saturdays. There are also a large number of ATMs around the town, where money can be withdrawn at any time of the day. Before leaving the country, students should be aware that an account can only be closed through the branch where it was opened.

What should you do before arriving in Svishtov?

Accommodation

Exchange students may apply for accommodation in the university's dormitories. There is an "Accommodation" section in the Application form where students can indicate their needs regarding accommodation.

All rooms at the dormitories are shared, so students will have one or two other room-mates. Rooms are equipped with essential furniture – a bed, table, chair and a small wardrobe. There are no kitchen facilities.

It is the students' responsibility to clean their rooms, the toilet, shower and other areas that they have access to. It is also the students' responsibility to buy their own cleaning materials.

We always try to have our rooms ready for our exchange students before their arrival. To ensure our success, please be kind enough to inform our ERASMUS office about the exact date and time of your arrival at least three weeks before.

Health Insurance

All Erasmus students coming to Bulgaria should have prepaid health insurance for the period that they are going to spend in the country. They are advised to visit polyclinics if they need medical treatment in Bulgaria.

If the student is a citizen of an EU member state or Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland and plans to stay temporarily (up to 90 days) in Bulgaria, he/she might consider obtaining the European Health Insurance Card. Presentation of the European Health Insurance Card guarantees the immediate reimbursement of medical costs, or soon after the student returns home.

If the student is not a citizen of any of these countries, he/she should check with his/her national authorities if entitlement is available for free or subsidised health treatment in Bulgaria.

Please note that public health care security does not cover all types of medical services, so students might consider supplementing it with private health insurance.

Entry and Legal Residency in Bulgaria

Visa

Depending upon their nationality, students may need to obtain a long-stay entry visa before coming to Bulgaria.

Residence permit

Unless the students are an EU/EEA or Swiss citizen, they may also need to finalise their application for a residence permit.

SECTION IV. INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACADEMY

Profile

The D. A. Tsenov Academy of Economics is one of the leading educational, scientific and cultural institutions in the Republic of Bulgaria. It is composed of four Faculties, sub-divided into their related Departments. There are also Academic Centres and Offices, the Institute for Scientific Research, the Academic Library, various administrative and service departments, and the Students' campus.

The Academy's talented academic staff is comprised of over 320 highly qualified professors, associate professors, assistant-professors and researchers. They educate over 12,500 Bulgarian and foreign full-time, part-time and distance learning students in Bachelor's, Master's and Ph.D. degree every year.

The Academy of Economics actively participates in a variety of European Union Programmes in collaboration with European universities, internationally funded scientific research projects, inter-university educational activities for students and multi-national higher education projects.

The History of the Academy

The foundation of the Economic Institute in Svishtov is interwoven with the town's history throughout the period of the Bulgarian National Revival. The town of Svishtov gained recognition as an important commercial centre where a number of educational and cultural institutions were founded during the bright years of the Bulgarian Renaissance. The town has been the birthplace of many patriotic Bulgarians and a centre of charitable and

beneficiary traditions that have aided the development of the local and national population. Progressive-minded merchants and intellectuals desired to measure the economic, cultural and intellectual growth of the town against European standards and development. This roused the zeal for renewal greatly. "The great flames" of patriotism and Renaissance enthusiasm gave rise to many benevolent acts that served the needs of education. In an article in the "Tsarigradski" newspaper in July, 1858, the town of Svishtov was pronounced "the Bulgarian capital of teaching".

The name of Dimitar Apostolov Tsenov stands out amongst the noble beneficiary figures from Svishtov, due to his invaluable contributions to the community and the country.

"Dimitar Tsenov is a great Bulgarian, a continuator of the glorious deeds of his predecessors", stated the Bulgarian Academician, Georgi Danailov.

A Decree signed by Tsar Boris III reads: "A Higher Education School of Commerce is being established in the town of Svishtov under the name "Dimitar Apostolov Tsenov" with the purpose of providing theoretical and practical knowledge in the specific areas of the economic science" (The State Gazette, vol. 200, Sept 5th, 1936). On November 8th 1936 Tsar Boris III officially opened the Higher Education School of Commerce in Svishtov.

The Academy of Economics vindicates the reputation of the Benefactor and carries the pride of Svishtov as an academic centre.

Quality of education

The National Agency for Assessment and Accreditation has awarded the Tsenov Academy of Economics with an institutional accreditation of 'Very Good'.

The Academy has been approved by the Lloyd's Register of Quality Assurance in accordance with the ISO standards for quality management.

Partnerships

The Academy of Economics has a full Erasmus Charter, and is entitled to use the statute of 'Erasmus University'. The Academy is a member of the European Universities Association (EUA) and the Association of Economic Universities in South and Eastern Europe (ASECU).

The European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)

The European credit transfer system (**ECTS**) has been applied within the framework of the Erasmus programme. ECTS is a system for the commensurability and comparison between educational mechanisms in different universities and countries that participate in international academic exchange.

“Credit” in the ECTS context represents a unit of work that the student must complete in connection with his/her education in a specific subject in order to successfully complete a semester or an academic year. Most frequently, credits represent the time spent by the student for the preparation of a given discipline, attendance at lectures and self-study assignments.

“The Grade” represents an index of student achievement when sitting an examination or implementing a concrete task, where different assessment systems are applied within different member states within the framework of the European Union. All of them are equated to ECTS standards, in this way securing equal representation amongst students from different European countries.

Marks awarded at the D. A. Tsenov Academy of Economics are awarded on a scale of 2-6 (6 being the highest). This corresponds to grades F-A (see <http://www.uni-svishtov.bg/default.asp?page=page&id=198>). If the grade is between 2.00 and 2.49, the student cannot sit the final exam. A certain number of credits are awarded for each examination.

Ensuring the eligibility of educational subjects and interdisciplinary subjects (the study of other faculty disciplines) are among the basic principles of the system. Students also have the opportunity to construct their own syllabus.

The principle applying to the ECTS framework is that there is a minimum requirement of the accumulation of 60 credits per academic year or 30 for each semester.
