3. The articles are not to exceed 5–8 pages in A4 format (3 pages – for the article abstracts), typed in MS Word. Typeface – Times New Roman Cyr; type size – 12; space 1,0; margins – 2 cm (upper and lower), 2 cm (left), 2 cm (right).
4. The head of the paper is to contain the author's requisites.
5. The paper's title is to be followed by the abstract and keywords (in English and the language the paper is written).
