Buddy Programme & Orientation Weeks



As an international student, you will be matched with a local "buddy" who will help you to get settled in Aschaffenburg. Your buddy, who will be a full-time student at Aschaffenburg UAS, will help you with all your administrative and social queries about moving to Aschaffenburg and during the orientation weeks.

Health Insurance

All students studying in Germany need a valid health insurance which is recognised in Germany. European citizens can send us a scan of their EU health insurance card to arrange for an exemption. Students from other countries may take out insurance from a German health insurance provider before or during the orientation weeks (~ 120 EUR per month).

Semester Fee

All students of Aschaffenburg UAS, including Erasmus+ and exchange students have to pay a semester fee of 60 EUR. You will receive further information after your application.

Arrival

The closest airport is Frankfurt am Main (\sim 50 km). From the airport you will easily get to Aschaffenburg via train. You can take a bus to get to the university from the main station in Aschaffenburg (5 minutes).
