PhD, Associate Professor (Personnel Management)



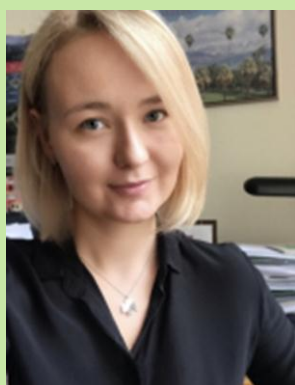
